Subject: - Observation of 'Cyber Jaagrookta (Awareness) Diwas ' on first Wednesday of every month

Sir/Madam

This refers to a D.O letter of Shri Ajay Bhalla , I.A.S. , Home Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs ,Government of India No 22003/15/2019-I4C dated 30th March 2022 on the subject mentioned above (copy is enclosed as ready reference as Annexure-1).

- 2. Ministry of Home Affairs has launched Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C) to strengthen the capabilities of Law Enforcement Agencies and also a National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP) to report the cyber crime incidents. It is evident from the DO letter that as per analysis of NCRP, 60% of the complaints are related to online financial frauds. The contents of letter and report of National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP), both are self explanatory.
- **3.** The increase of number of internet users in India and rapidly evolving technologies are solving many real life problems but comes with their own challenges of Financial Frauds, Phishing, Hacking, Cyber Stalking etc.
- **4**. With a view to raise awareness about 'Cyber Hygiene' Ministry of Home Affairs requested all Ministries/Departments to observe Cyber Jagrookta Diwas (CJD) on the first Wednesday of every month with special emphasis on capacity building of officials and citizens to deal with challenges of cyber crime.
- **5**. Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre has shared a write up on the Cyber Jagrookta Diwas (Annexure 1 of D.O.) in which, need of mass awareness on cyber crimes has been explained in detail along with topics to be covered while observing Cyber Jagrookta Diwas.
- **6**. The aim of this initiative is to create awareness for the prevention of cyber crimes through workshops, seminars, interactive sessions, quiz competitions, based practices, case studies, and creative sessions on first Wednesday of every month time .As no budget is available for the organization of this programme, District NYK may therefore dovetail this programme with core and special programmes of NYKS. District NYKs can also explore possibilities to organize this programme through collaboration with Departments/Agencies by mobilizing local resources.
