

Action Plan for organizing Swachh Bharat Mission 2014-15

All Offices of NYKS, namely, Head Office at New Delhi, 29 Zonal Offices in States and District Nehru Yuva Kendra in 623 Districts will be engaged in Swachh Bharat Mission activities. The Pledge will be administered to all officials as well as 12,000 NYC volunteers. The 2.77 lakh youth clubs affiliated to NYKS (with 8 million members) will also be motivated to take up activities on 'Swachhta Bharat' in their respective villages by mobilizing local resources.

Following programmes and activities would be organized through District NYKs, NYC Volunteers and village based Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals across the country.

- District NYKs will motivate members of village based Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals as a result of which members of Youth Clubs would undertake special Cleanliness Drives in their respective areas.
- The members of Youth Clubs would further motivate villagers in their respective villages to take active

- To make visible and highlight the Mission Programmes among masses, a variety of activities such as rallies, short run for cleanliness, sanitation and hygiene, essay and slogan writing, cleaning drives and community based activities will be undertaken.

As you are aware that Swachh Bharat Mission is one of the priority areas of Govt. of India and NYKS has to play a vital role to make the Mission a complete success. NYKS has already propagated the issues of cleanliness, sanitation and hygiene, awareness and education among rural masses in general and youths in particular. The Mission was launched by all Zonal offices and District NYKs on 2nd October 2014 with the active support of NYC Volunteers and affiliated Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals. A variety of activities such as relies, short run for cleanliness, sanitation & hygiene, essay and slogan writing, cleanliness drives and community based activities were undertaken. IEC material on Swachh Bharat Mission including Logo and Appeal of Hon'ble Prime Minister of India has been provided to Youth Clubs & Mahila Mandals for distribution among villagers.

It is expected that members of Youth Clubs & Mahila Mandals are motivating people to dedicate 100 hrs. (02 hrs in a week) of their time to contribute to make India clean. Youth Club members must have motivated villagers for construction of sanitary latrine with the technical and financial support of form concerned Departments/Agencies. It has been decided that this campaign should be continued during financial year 2014-15.

As per the directions of Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India, NYKS has prepared an Annual Action Plan on Swachh Bharat Mission for the year 2014-15. The programmes & activities included in Annual Action Plan, are to be organized by utilizing the services of NYC Volunteers and NYK Youth Clubs & Mahila Mandals with the support and guidance of Deputy Directors and District Youth Coordinators in all 623 District NYKs in mission mode rather than a routine exercise. The Plan of Action is **enclosed** herewith for further necessary action. The activities of the Plan should be organized on voluntary basis in coordination with concerned Department and Agencies as well as service providers. Minimum Swachh Bharat activities target set for each District NYK is **based** on the number of NYC Volunteers allotted in a District.

The Deputy Directors and District Youth Coordinators besides monitoring should provide full support, guidance and facilitate and NYC Volunteers and Youth Clubs for the successful implementation of proposed activities in coordinating with concerned Departments and Agencies in the District on voluntary basis with zeal and gaiety.

Apart from this, the major focus of 100 Districts covered under year long programme "Punarjagaran" would be on activities under Swachh Bharat Mission.

In view of the above, necessary instructions may be issued to all Deputy Directors and District Youth Coordinators working under your jurisdiction should ensure that set targets towards Swachh Bharat Mission are achieved by end of March 2015. The report should be submitted to NYKS Hqr. on 1st & 15th of every month. Further, a cumulative report on Swachh Bharat upto 15th November, 2014 may be furnished in the prescribed performa to NYKS Hqr. latest by 26h November, 2014.

Following programmes and activities have been planned for organization through District NYKs, NYC Volunteers and village based Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals across the country.

Awareness Campaigns

- In order to further propagate the issues of cleanliness, sanitation & hygiene, awareness & education components would be mainstreamed in NYKS ongoing Core Programmes, Training Programmes, Coordination Activities, National Integration Camps, Adventure Camps, Life Skill Education Programmes, Youth Leadership & Personality Development Programme, etc.
- District NYKs will motivate members of village based Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals as a result of which members of Youth Clubs would undertake special Cleanliness Drives in their respective areas.
- The members of Youth Clubs would further motivate villagers in their respective villages to take active part in the Mission and make their village clean.

Strategic Utilization of Services of National Youth Corps (NYC) Volunteers and NYK Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals with the support and guidance of Deputy Director and District Youth Coordinator

- It has been targeted that around 8,500 NYC volunteer deployed by NYKs in 623 districts. Therefore, their services of this deployed volunteer force should be optimally utilized for implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission. For this purpose, they should be given informal training in line with the expectations of the Swachh Bharat Mission activities in identified focused areas.
- NYC volunteer should look after a cluster of villages having Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals for implementation of NYKS targeted Swachh Bharat Activities and follow up activities in their respective blocks or cluster of villages.
- The youth who would be covered under NYK Swachh Bharat Activities should be motivated and supported to
 organize similar awareness and education programmes in their respective villages. For this purpose, they
 should be facilitated by designated NYC volunteers and resource persons on the identified issues in which
 they have undergone exposure under Swachh Bharat Mission Programmes & Activities.

 In order to quantify the qualitative outcome, each NYC Volunteer should be assigned targets. Nonetheless, the focus should be on the selected area as mentioned above.

Swachh Bharat Activities which NYKs may take up through Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals

Besides facilitating implementation of NYKS 09 Core Programs and Coordination Activities, following are the minimum Swachh Bharat Activities' targets set for each district NYK and is based on the number of NYCs allotted in a district. These activities should be taken up with active partnership of NYC Volunteers and participation of Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals in the district. This should be achieved by mobilizing local resources and in coordination with other departments and agencies during 2014-15. For this purpose, the Deputy Director/District Youth Coordinator besides monitoring should provide full support, guidance and facilitate NYC volunteers and Youth Club leaders for the successful implementation of proposed activities in coordinating with other development Departments and agencies in the district.

Swachh Bharat Activities to be carried out during 2014-15 in coordination with other departments and agencies as well as service providers which NYKs Deputy Director/ District Youth Coordinator is to take up through deployed NYC Volunteers and existing Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals in 623 district NYKs

Following programmes and activities have been planned for organization through District NYKs, NYC Volunteers and village based Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals across the country.

Awareness Campaigns

- In order to further propagate the issues of cleanliness, sanitation &hygiene, awareness & education components would be mainstreamed in NYKS ongoing Core Programmes, Training Programmes, Coordination Activities, National Integration Camps, Adventure Camps, Life Skill Education Programmes, Youth Leadership & Personality Development Programme, etc.
- District NYKs will motivate members of village based Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals as a result of which members of Youth Clubs would undertake special Cleanliness Drives in their respective areas.
- The members of Youth Clubs would further motivate villagers in their respective villages to take active
 part in the Mission and make their villages clean.
- Members of Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals would motivate people to dedicate 100 hours (2 hours in a week) of their time every year to contribute to make India clean and this campaign would be a continues process.
- In UNFPA supported Adolescent Health and Development Project the component on Swachh Bharat Mission would be introduced in the curriculum of Peer Educators and Teen Club members (out of school adolescents).
- Members of 1000 village based Teen Clubs will undertake one day long cleanliness campaign every alternative month during the project period.
- Swachh Bharat Mission would be made one of the important parameters while selecting Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals for conferring awards under the Scheme of Awards to Outstanding Youth Clubs (AOYC) for the year 2015-16 to 2018-19. (based on the activities undertaken by applicant Youth Clubs during previous year).
- A component on Swachh Bharat Mission would be introduced in the curriculum of NYC Volunteers.
- During the course of conduct of Youth Club Development Programme, people in general and youths in
 particular would be made aware and mobilized about the Swachh Bharat Mission and Construction of
 Toilets under Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan through a network of village based Youth Clubs and Mahila
 Mandals.

- NYKS is implementing a year-long programme called 'Punarjagaran' (Rejuvenation), covering 100 Districts of the country. The programme has started on 02.10.2014 and will culminate on 25.09.2015. During this period, a youth movement will be created in the country, involving the youth in constructive activities. The Programme has been initiated from 4 corners of India, namely, Leh in North, Okha in West, Kanya Kumari in South and Anini (Dibang Valley) in North East. The Programme will move from these 4 Districts towards Mathura (UP), the birth place of Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya, where the Programme will culminate on 25.09.2015, the birth centenary of Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya. This initiative will mobilise about 150 million youth and also inspire youth in all over the country. During this Programme, activities under 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' will be a major area of focus.

Subject: Swachh Bharat Abhiyan -25th September 2014 to 2nd October 2014 and Beyond

As you are aware that Hon'ble Prime Minister of India has given a call for "Swachh Bharat" as a mass movement to realize Gandhiji's dream of a Clean India by the 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi in 2019. Once Gandhi Ji said that "Sanitation is more important than political freedom". Hon'ble Prime Minister has appealed the people to donate 100 hours (2 hours in a week) to make India Clean and Green. He has desired that a nation-wide Abhiyan be organized with the participation of all sections of society to bring about mass awareness and a lasting behavioural change to achieve this goal.

- 2. Vide letter of even number dated 22nd September 2014, Shri L.K. Gupta, Joint Secretary, Youth Affairs has issued a detailed Action Plan of the Department for implementation of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. The Action Plan lists out steps to be taken during the period 25.09.2014 to 02.10.2014 and beyond.
- 3. In this context, NYKS has decided that an intensive cleanliness & hygiene campaign be undertaken by all district Nehru Yuva Kendras by involving NYC volunteers, affiliated Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals and other key stake holders in the districts from 25th September, 2014, Birth anniversary of Pt. Deendayal Upadhayaya and Pledge taking on Swachh Bharat Abhiyan on 2nd October 2014. This 1st Phase of sustained campaign would culminate on 31st October, the birthday of Sardar Patel.

It is reiterated that Zonal Directors should ensure that Pledge on Swachhta on 2nd October 2014 should be administered to all officials of Zonal & District offices and NYC Volunteers of NYKS as well as all NYKS Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals in a function. The Programme should be taken very seriously and on top priority. Report should reach to Hqr. by 5th of October 2014 for submission to Ministry. Zonal Directors should personally monitor the activities under this Abhiyan.

- 4. Launching function of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan should be organized with great zeal and gaiety at district Hqr. During the launching function, Hon'ble Ministers, MPs, MLAs, burocrates, eminent persons from all sections of the society may be involved. As per guidelines of Annual Action Plan 2014-15, Birth anniversary of Pt. Deendayal Upadhayaya, is mandatorily to be observed by district NYKs. Rs. 50,000/- for observance of minimum 18 important days have already been released. Therefore, expenditure may be made out of observance of days of national and international importance programme head.
- 5. A variety of activities such as pledge taking, rallies, prabhat pheri, short run for cleanliness, sanitation & hygiene, debates, seminars, lectures by Resource Persons, street plays, poster making, painting and quiz competitions, essay and slogan writing, distribution of pamphlets and other IEC material, wall writing, cleaning drives and other community activities may be undertaken to focus public attention on this campaign and on the need for cleanliness & hygiene.
- 6. The members of Youth Clubs & Mahila Mandals should be motivated to undertake Special Cleanliness Drive in their respective areas. Cleaning Drive includes, eradication of weeds, collection of polythene bags and plastic material for disposal, maintenance of public property (anganwadi centres, PHCs, etc.), sheds on road sides and bus stand, cleanliness of street and common places, maintenance and repair of cremation grounds, maintenance of play grounds, schools and community toilets, digging, maintenance, disinfection, de-silting and repair of ponds, wells, natural drinking water resources, small irrigation channels, water tanks, water harvesting, etc.

- 7. Effective use of mass media such as radio, television and newspapers, digital media such internet and mobile, etc. may be made in this regard.
- 8. While the campaign will begin on 25th September, 2014, all offices of NYKS, namely Zonal Offices in the States and district NYKs will ensure that on 2nd October, 2014 "Swachhta Shapath" (pledge) is administered to all officials as well as NYC Volunteers. District NYKs will motivate all affiliated Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals affiliated with District NYKs to take the Swachhta Shapath (pledge) in public functions to be organized by them in their villages. The text of the pledge will be sent to you separately.
- 9. Ensure cleanliness in office complexes of District and Zonal offices. Toilets and garbage places should be cleaned.
- 10. The issues of Cleanliness and Sanitation Education should be made integral part of NYKS Programmes; developing training module on "Swachh Bharat" and organizing Workshops and Training Programmes for Youth Club Leaders/Members, NYC Volunteers and NYKS field officials.
- 11. Members of NYKs Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals and NYC Volunteers should motivate villagers for construction of sanitary latrines. Necessary technical and financial support and required resources may be mobilized from concerned Departments/Agencies. District Youth Coordinators and Zonal Directors should hold meetings will all concerned individuals, Public Representatives, Youth Leaders and other Stake Holders to make the Abhiyan effective and successful.
- 12. **Global Hand Washing Day** on 15th October and the **World Toilet Day** on 19th November may be observed to spread the message of cleanliness.
- 13. The Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) may be motivated to take up development and maintenance of Parks/Roads etc. around their offices and also sponsor construction of toilets for girl children in schools and colleges.
- 14. The concerned Zonal Directors will ensure to implement a year long programme called 'Punarjagaran' (Rejuvenation), covering 100 Districts of the country. The programme will launch on 2nd October 2014 and will culminate on 25th September 2015. Draft document in this regard has already been issued vide this office letter of even number dated 23rd September 2014.
- 15. Achievements under 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' will be made an important parameter while selecting Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals for conferring awards under the scheme of Awards to Outstanding Youth Clubs (AOYC) for the year 2015-16 (based on the activities undertaken by applicant youth clubs during 2014-15).
- 16. I urge all of you for your personal intervention and indulgence to spread the message of making India Clean and Green among all NYK functionaries such as members of Youth Clubs and Mahila Mandals, NYC volunteers and other key stake holders in the districts and motivate them to organize and participate wholeheartedly in this campaign.
- 17. Furnish an Action Plan of your zone in respect of activities/ events/ functions planned for the campaign on 25th September, 2014 and onwards in the enclosed format. Action Taken Report (ATR) may be furnished by **7th October 2014** positively, for onward submission to Department of Youth Affairs, which will be submitted to the Cabinet Secretariat.
- 18. Progress Report in the enclosed format be submitted on fortnightly basis to NYKS Hqr along with press clippings and few action photographs.
