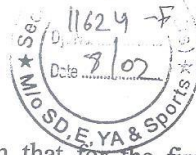

I am pleased to inform that for the first time "Compendium of Laws on Disaster Management" has been formulated by NDMA. The document has been prepared in association with West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences. Target beneficiary of this Compendium will be all the Departments/officials involved in the disaster risk reduction interventions. The document has been formulated, keeping in view the urgent need to bring together all the relevant Acts/Rules together, so as to facilitate and strengthen the institutional mechanism for disaster management.

2. The Compendium has been formulated through a wide consultative process, involving the stakeholders concerned and comprises four parts namely Introduction, General Acts (Central Level) and Disaster Specific Acts/Rules, State Acts/Rules and NDMA Guidelines/Reports. The document contains 103 Acts/Rules/Notifications in 15 disaster/incident specific chapters on Fire, Explosive, Flood/Dam Burst/Tsunami, Cyclone, Lightning, Earthquake, Biological Disaster, Chemical/Industrial/Nuclear, Poisoning, Accident, Stampede, Epidemic, Cloud Burst, Pest Attack, Drought and Frost & Cold Wave.

3. Significantly, the document also contains the Judicial Pronouncements and cases relevant to specific sections of various Acts discussed.

4. Compendium of Laws on Disaster Management is available on NDMA Website <http://www.ndma.gov.in/en/> on Home Page and under Policy & Plan section. It is requested that all concerned Departments & other stakeholders may kindly be informed about the Compendium.
