Subject: **Guidelines for organisation of Hindi Diwas/ Fortnight (Pakhwara) for the year 2015-2016.**

With a view to generate awareness and promote the use of Hindi in Official work, it has been decided to celebrate 14<sup>th</sup> September as Hindi Diwas and 14<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 as Hindi Fortnight (Pakhwara). Hindi Day/Pakhwara is being celebrated every year by the Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan at Head office, Zonal office, and district level Nehru Yuva Kendra. Although the celebration is marked by participation of youth and employees in large numbers, however for last few years a scheme has been envisaged under Mass Awareness Campaign to organise programmes at all levels for implementation of the Official Language and related publicity.

Keeping in view the participation of Youth, in large numbers, an activity schedule has been prepared for implementation by every district from 14<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2015. In the light of the Guidelines issued by the Department of Official Language and taking into account the infrastructural capacity of the Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan, the following programmes have been envisaged - **Hindi Day Celebration, Rajbhasha Exhibition, Seminar, Essay Competition, Noting and Drafting, Hindi Correspondence, Hindi Sulekh, Letter Writing, Slogan Writing, Kavi Sammelan, Debate Competition, Cultural programme (Hindi Natak, Dance and Song, Hindi Poem) Sammelan, Valedictory and Prize Distribution .**

According to the declared policy of Govt. Of India, different programmes have been designed for A, B & C Regions. A copy of detailed programme is enclosed herewith. You may also contact district level officers like field Publicity Officer, District Official Languages Officer and Town Official Languages Implementation Committee, for the successful execution of the programmes. You are requested to invite the Member of Parliamentary Committee on Official Language (List enclosed) of your District/area.

Distt. NYK can make expenditure for fortnight celebration out of the celebration head of Annual Action Plan 2015 – 2016 and Zonal Office will make expenditure out of Rs. 3,000/- which have been sent through letter no. **NYKS/Acct. Bank/Rel./2015-16** dated **10-09-2015**.
