

OBSERVANCE OF CONSTITUTION DAY- 26TH NOVEMBER, 2022

The constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution of India on 26th November, 1949 which became effective on 26th January, 1950. Constitution Day or Samvidhan Diwas in India therefore is celebrated every year on 26th November to honour and remember the father of Constitution Dr B R Ambedkar; and to spread the importance of the Constitution of India and how it is helpful towards the growth and development of the country.

Apart from the conduct of the Core Program- Know Your Constitution- Civic Awareness Program, the following mass mobilization and participation programs are to be organized across the country by all the field offices as part of Constitution Day.

- 1. Reading of the Preamble of Constitution online at 11:00 a.m. on 26th November, 2022** shall be conducted at all Regional Directorates, State Offices and District NYK offices using the link <https://readpreamble.nic.in> . The preamble is available in 22 languages and e-certificates will be automatically generated online for all the participants. This activity shall also be conducted by **NYVs, registered volunteers and at all affiliated youth clubs** so that the mass reading of Preamble becomes a event of scale and wider outreach.
- 2. Online quiz on India-the Mother of Democracy** available at government portal-<https://constitutionquiz.nic.in> must be popularised widely among NYVs, NYK youth Clubs, registered volunteers and youth & public in general so that awareness through the competition is raised among the masses. The participants shall receive autogenerated e-certificates upon completion.
- 3. Kartavya Samvaads** may be organized by NYVs, Registered Volunteers and Youth Clubs at the grassroot level so as to raise awareness on the fundamental duties of Citizen as mentioned in the Constitution. **Administering of Pledge on Fundamental Duties**-based on Preamble of the Constitution and Fundamental Duties may also be conducted.
- 4. Programs- Street plays, flash mobs etc and Competitions- Essay, Quiz, Elocution, Painting etc.** may be organized by the district NYKs under the theme of Know Your Constitution for buzz creation and awareness on Constitution of India.
- 5. Social Media Buzz creation and activities-** Webinars, Quiz, Did You Know series of posts etc. may be carried out till 26th November, 2022 tagging @NYKSIndia and with hashtag #knowyourconstitution so that it becomes trending on all social media platforms.

The above-mentioned activities shall be conducted through the voluntary efforts of the NYVs, Volunteers and Youth Clubs. Funds to the tune of 3000/- may also be utilized from the head of Observance of Days and Weeks of National and International Importance to support organization of these additional programs.
