Dear Zonal Directors,

Enclosed please find herewith the detailed operational guidelines with slot wise detailed timeline, implementation plan, district wise & state wise budget details along with reporting formats for the implementation of Punarjagaran Programme.

You are requested to go through the guidelines thoroughly and share it with concerned DYCs and DDs of your zone for immediate implementation of the programme.

The funds for district level Punarjagaran programme for 20 districts & printing of compendium & procurement of T-shirts & Caps for all 33 districts of Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Gujarat, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam and J&K in the 1st slot of Punarjagaran Programme are enclosed. The same are being released through RTGS by Director (FBA), NYKS Hqtrs for the organization of Punarjagaran Programme.

Meanwhile, the Zonal Directors of remaining 80 districts of the Punarjagaran Programme should complete the following process by 31st March, 2015 as per enclosed guidelines <u>without incurring financial liabilities</u> so that the Punarjagaran Yatra can be started from 30th April 2015 in 2nd and 3rd Slot.:-

- Villages selection
- Material for compendium and publicity material
- Brainstorming Sessions for establishing strategies and developing action plan.
- Formation of State, District and Panchayat Level organizing committees and organization of advocacy & sensitization meeting.
- Selection of Spear head team
- Chariot Design, negotiation
- Route planning as per slots
- Pre-Punarjagaran Campaign
- Pre Launching function
- Press and Media Campaigns & Meetings
- DACYP meeting

As soon as the funds are made available by the Ministry to NYKS, the same will be sent to remaining 80 districts and zones for the implementation of the programme. \wedge
