Madam/Sir,

Please refer to NYKS Hqtrs letter no. NYKS/NPYAD-NIC/2019-20/13 (F.No. 355) dated 08.08.2019 in which guidelines for organising National Integration Camps under NPYAD for the year 2019-20 has been sent.

In this connection, it is to inform you that the National Integration Camp will be organised on the theme of "Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat". The activities of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat would be including while organising the National Integration Camps. The following activities to be included as mentioned below:-

Home Stay- Home Stay programme (to the extent possible) for the participants of NIC
with host district families would be able to bring them closer to each other's way of life,
develop mutual understanding about their cultures, traditions, languages and have
interactions for developing deep and lasting bonds.

- Shramdaan (Work Camp):- As a part programme of EBSB, Shramdaan (Work Camp) would be undertaken by the participants of the pairing States. The objective is to inculcate sense of dignity of labour, volunteerism and generate collective response for developing/improving selected community asset.
- Language Learning:- Language difference can also bring togetherness and the same was evident during Language Learning. As a part of strategy; 20 Standard Sentences (such as Good Morning; what is your name, which part of India you belong etc.)
- Culinary Festival:- Culinary Festival; a part programme of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat provided good opportunities for the participants to know about the food and eating habits of each other.
- Screening of the Films and Documents:- The State Specific screening of Films and
 Documentaries would enable participants of states to have knowledge and better
 understanding about each other's flora and fauna, heritage, social customs and other
 uniqueness.
- Traditional Games and Sports:- Sharing of information and knowledge about each other brings in better understanding. Organisation of area specific Local Games and sports during the camp would provide greater interactive opportunities for the participants.
- Discussion, Declamation and Know India Quiz:- Discussion, Declamation and Know India Quiz are important activities which would create platform for interaction, exchange of views of participants from various States and more importantly knowing various aspects of our country.
- Cultural Festival:- Cultural Festivals are very effective medium for exchange of distinct cultural heritage and knowing each other's cultural uniqueness.

• Costumes and Dresses Uniqueness:- Knowing each other's costumes and dress and having sense of appreciation brings greater understanding and deeper bond.

Important instruction should be followed during the organisation of National Integration Camp:-

- National Integration Camp should be organised on the theme of Ek Bharat Shreshtha
 Bharat
- Logo of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat should be included on the banners of the programmes. For ready reference the logo is enclosed as Annexure-1
- Participants from paired States of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat have to be invited as per the guidelines of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat. The list of paired states is enclosed as Annexure-2. It is reiterated that it is mandatory to invite paired states. For example when NIC is organised in Punjab State then the participants from Andhra Pradesh State have to be invited and similarly the same pattern should be followed for other paired States organising NICs.
- Activities of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat as mentioned above have to be included in the NIC activities.
- Attempt should be made to organise NIC in your State which coincides with respective State's foundation Days. List of enclosed as Annexure 3.
